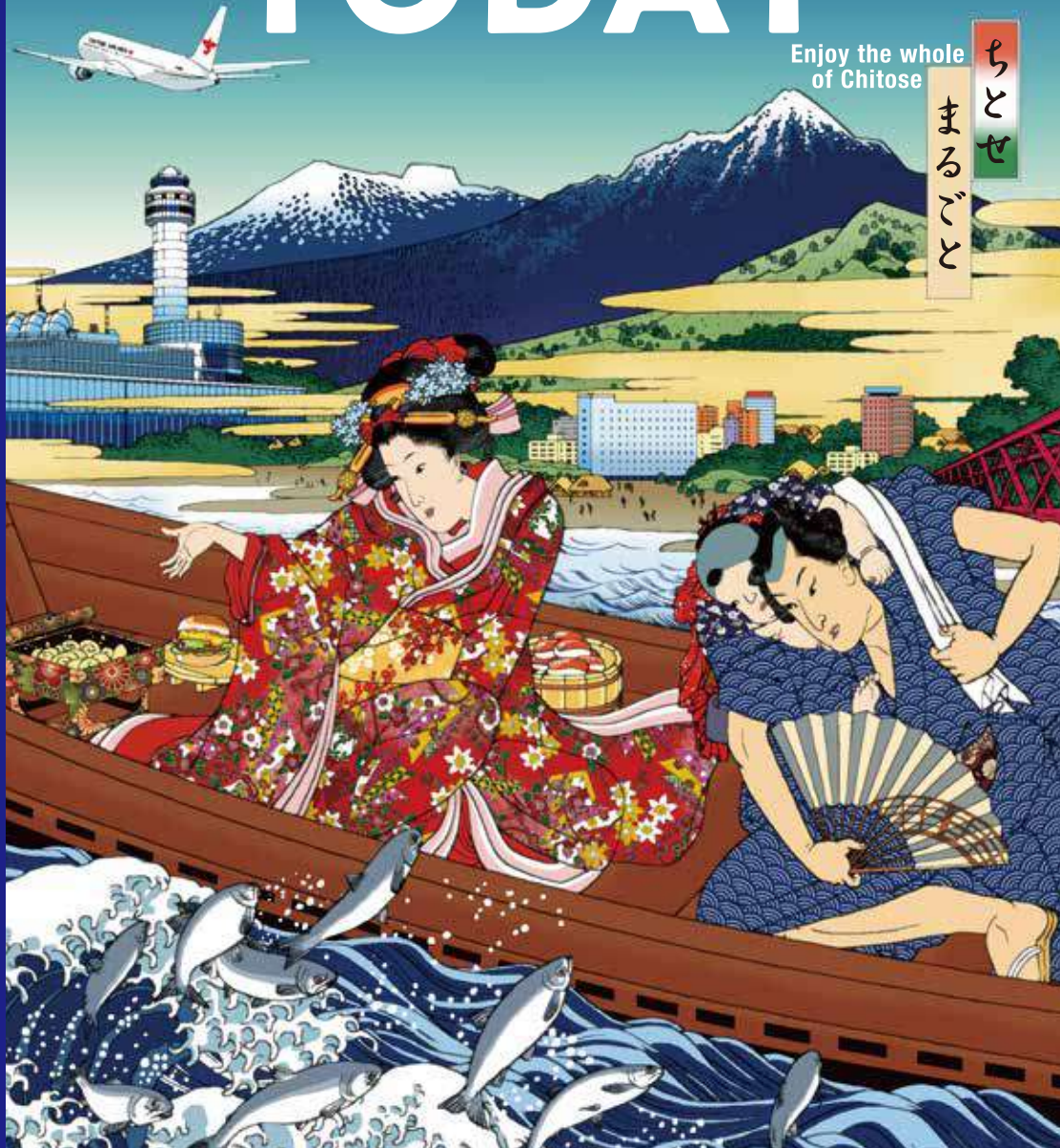


## What kind of city is Chitose?





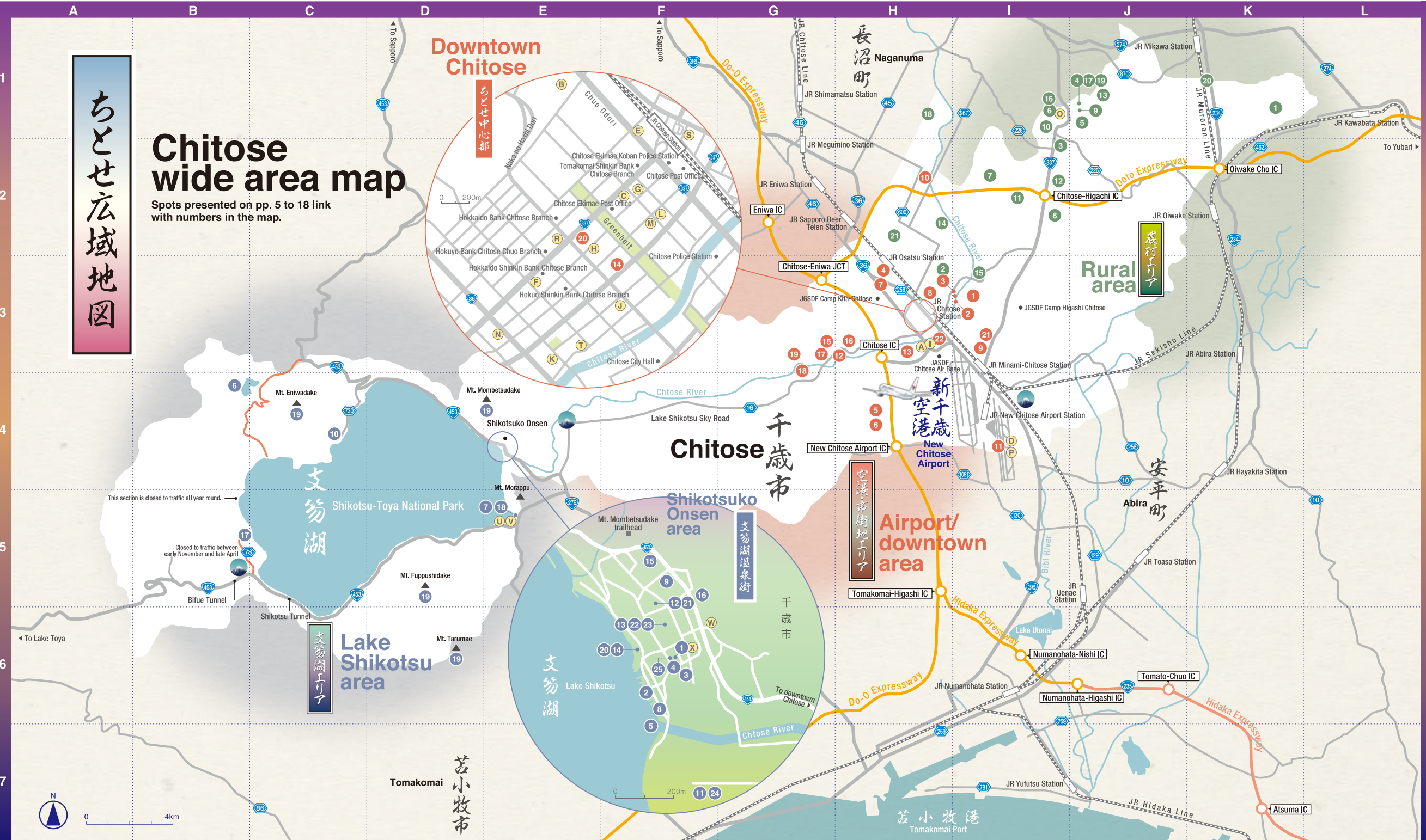
